The Wyoming Section of SME has elected to continue to award the Coates, Wolff, Russell, & Swank Memorial Mining Industry Scholarships to college students based on the following criteria:

1. Up to four \$1,500 scholarships will be available for the 2009-2010 school year.
2. Applicant must be a legal resident of the State of Wyoming.
3. Applicant must have class standing of Sophomore, Junior, or Senior.
4. Recipients are eligible for award consideration through their Senior year.
5. Fields of study should relate to mining, engineering, geology, environmental sciences, or other mineral extractive disciplines.
6. A **2.75 GPA** equivalent in the numerical point system will be required for eligibility.
7. Completion of the Educational Data section is mandatory (see application).
8. A 250 word written essay on the topic, "The Importance of Mineral Extraction to the State of Wyoming", must accompany the application.

A copy of the application form is enclosed. Applications may be photocopied. Please complete the form and return it along with the essay post marked by **DECEMBER 1, 2009.**

Additional data or transcripts may be included for further consideration. The essay and completion of the Educational Data section are mandatory for consideration.
